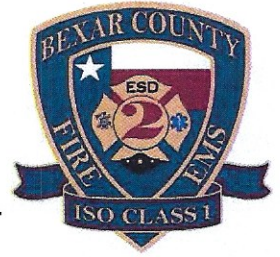

The estimated completion will be mid-summer of 2024. The foundation at the hall has been resolved with a \$29k change order. The project is on schedule - Josh/Ralph • Station 123 - Marksmen Construction started construction on August 2, 2023. The estimated completion date is September/October of 2024. During testing of earthwork, MTR noticed a test result that was not to plan. This led to a 3 week hold on the project until a solution to the base could be determined. The plasticity approved by Alpha met Alpha's GeoTechnical Recommendations but not MTR's design. This has been resolved that the project has continued. 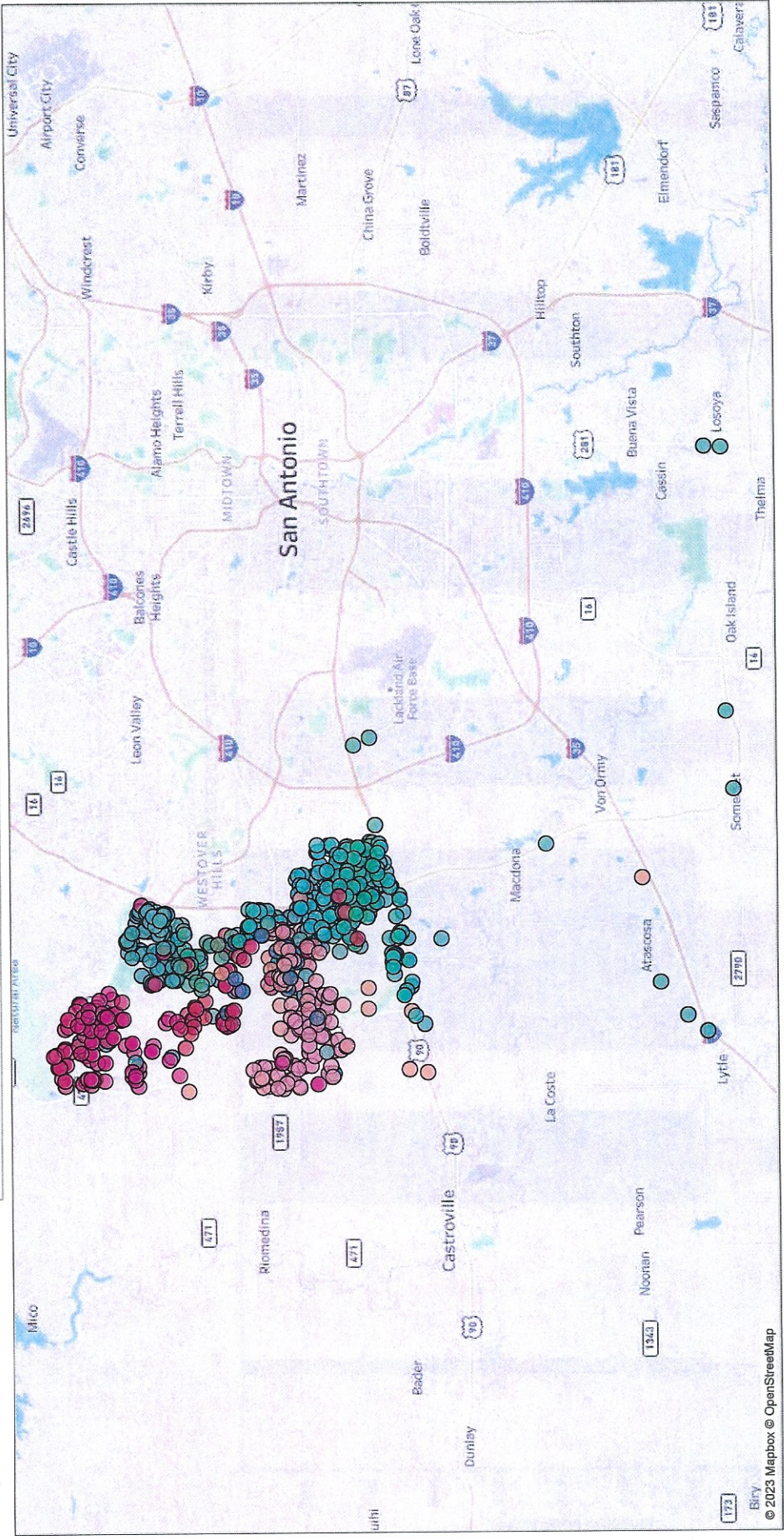

Fire / EMS Incidents by NFIRS Report Incident Type

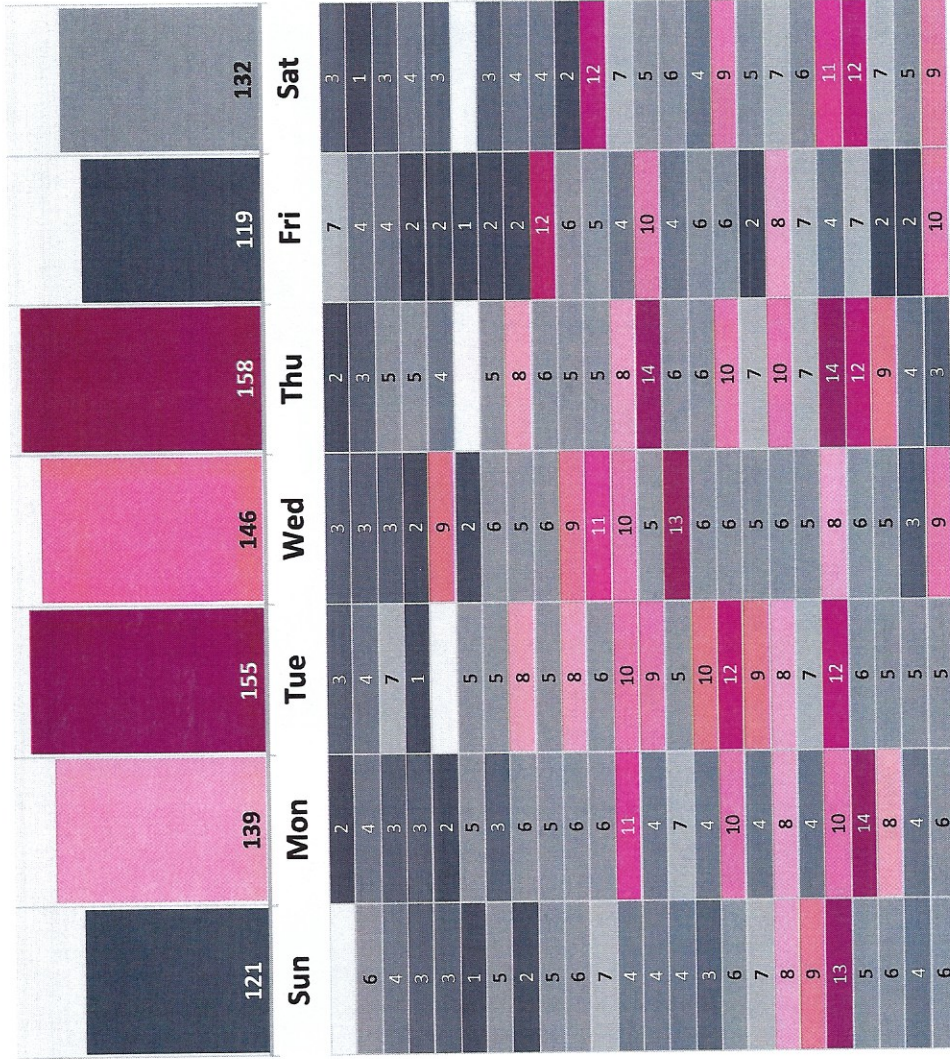

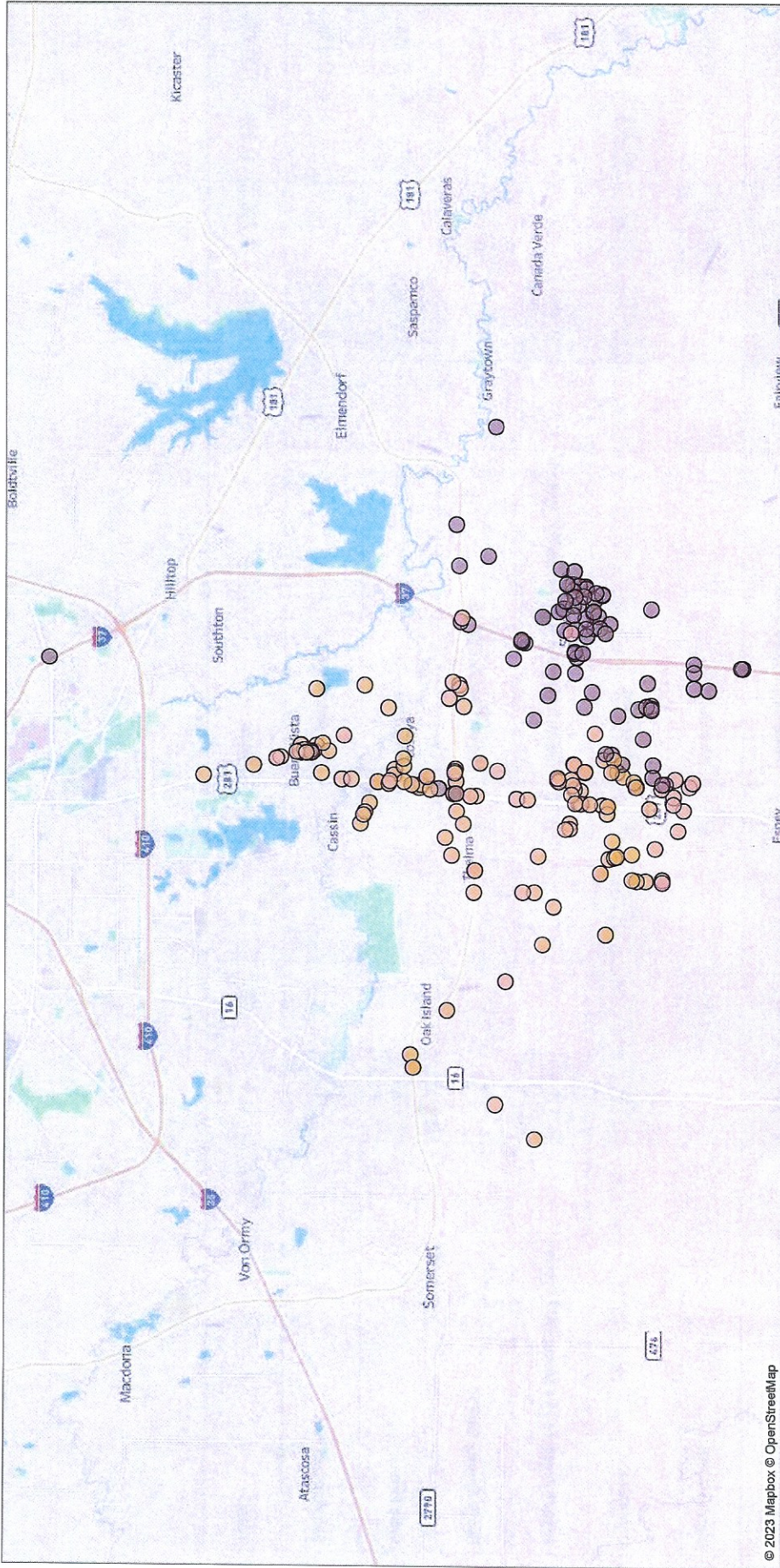
Incident Locations by Responding Station

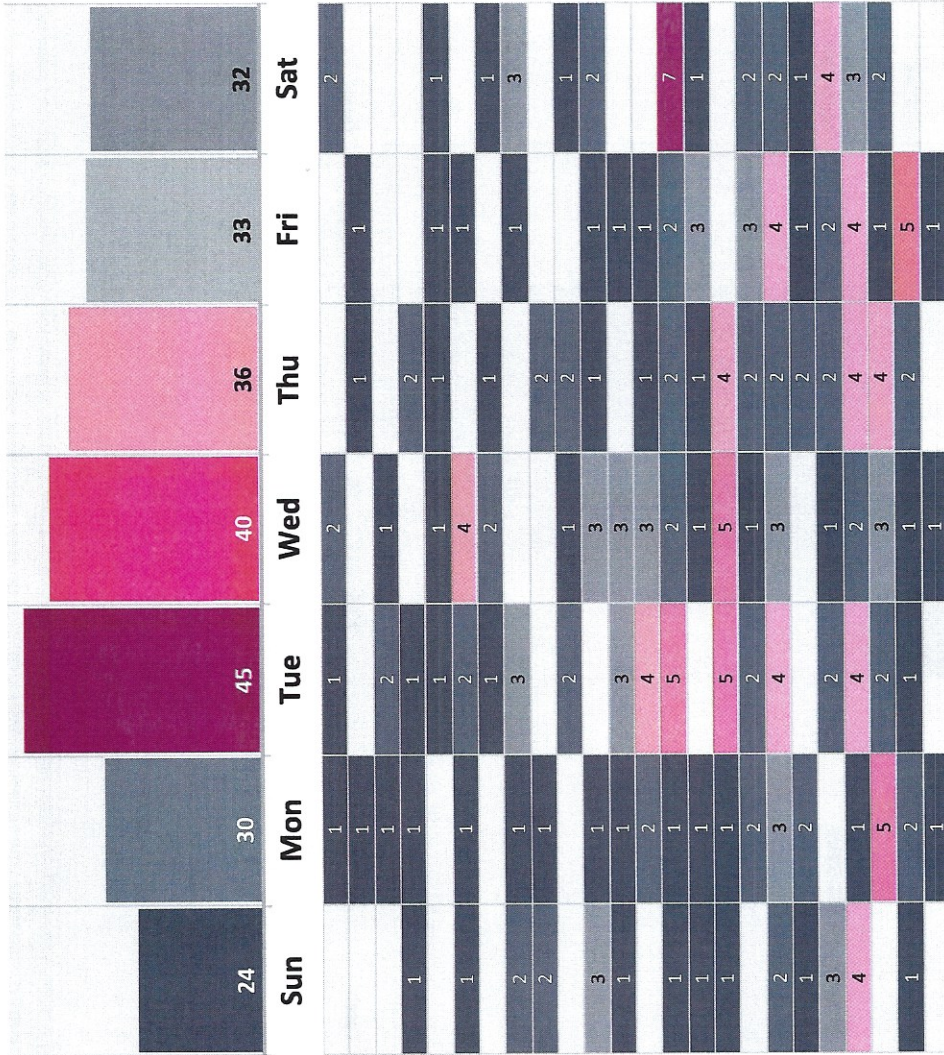

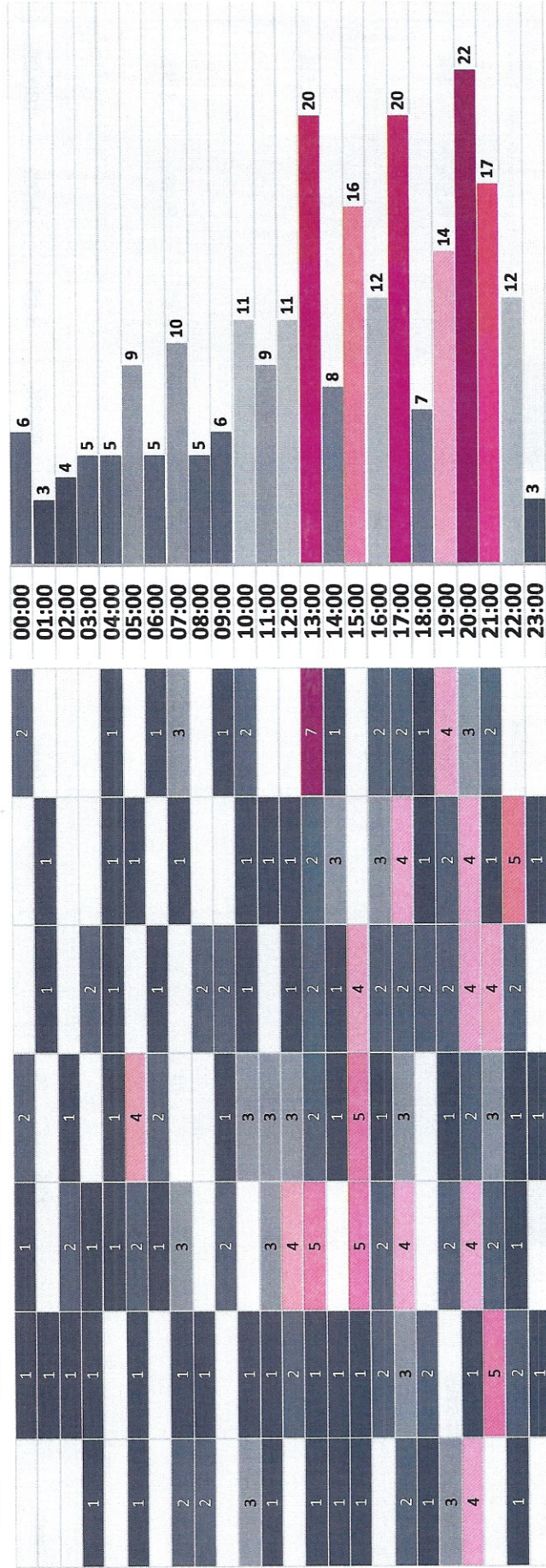
