The estimated completion will be mid-summer of 2024. All buildings except the Hall have been demolished. Groundwork has started for the new foundation which should be poured by mid March. - Josh/Ralph Martinez Rosario has wrapped up their review and begun to send documentation to AVA for 2022 Audit. 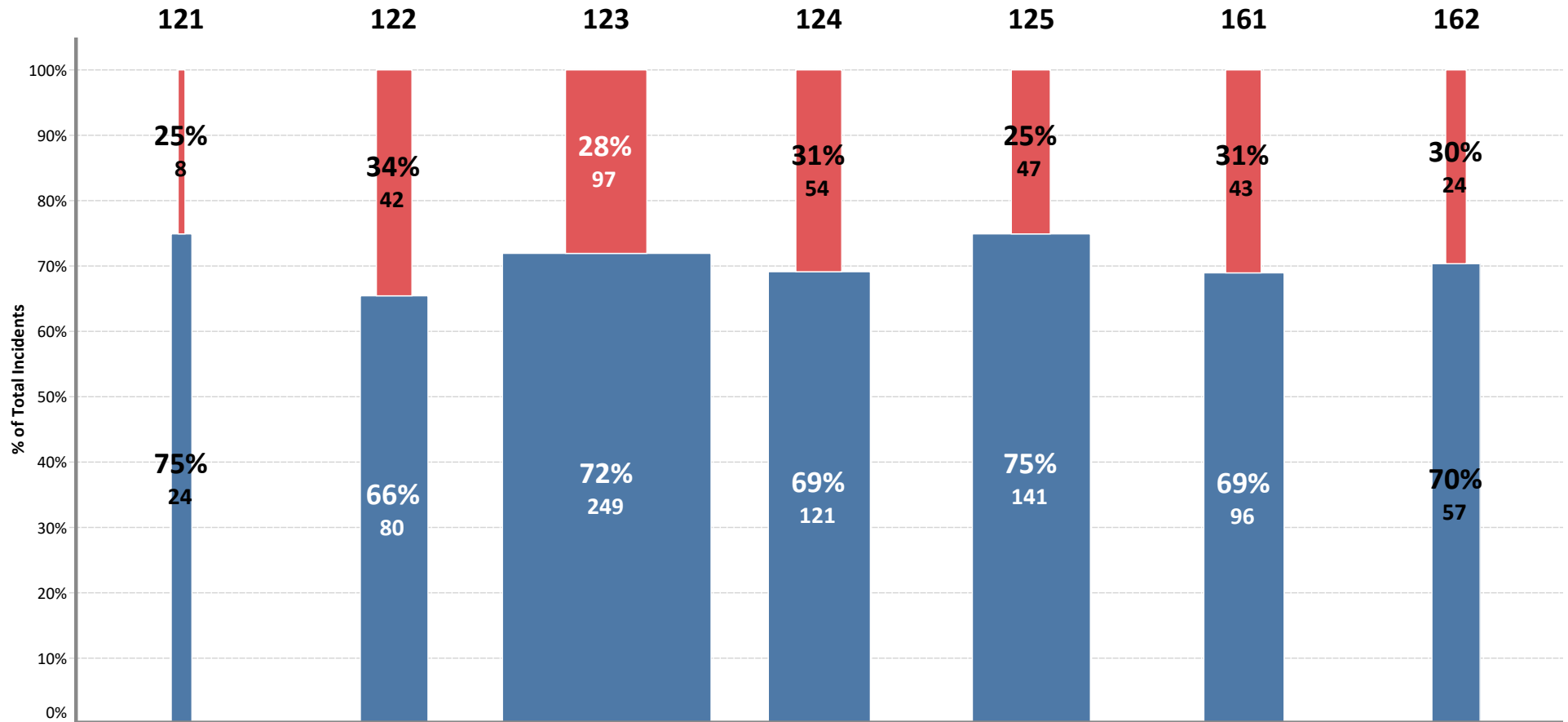

Fire / EMS Incidents by NFIRS Report Incident Type



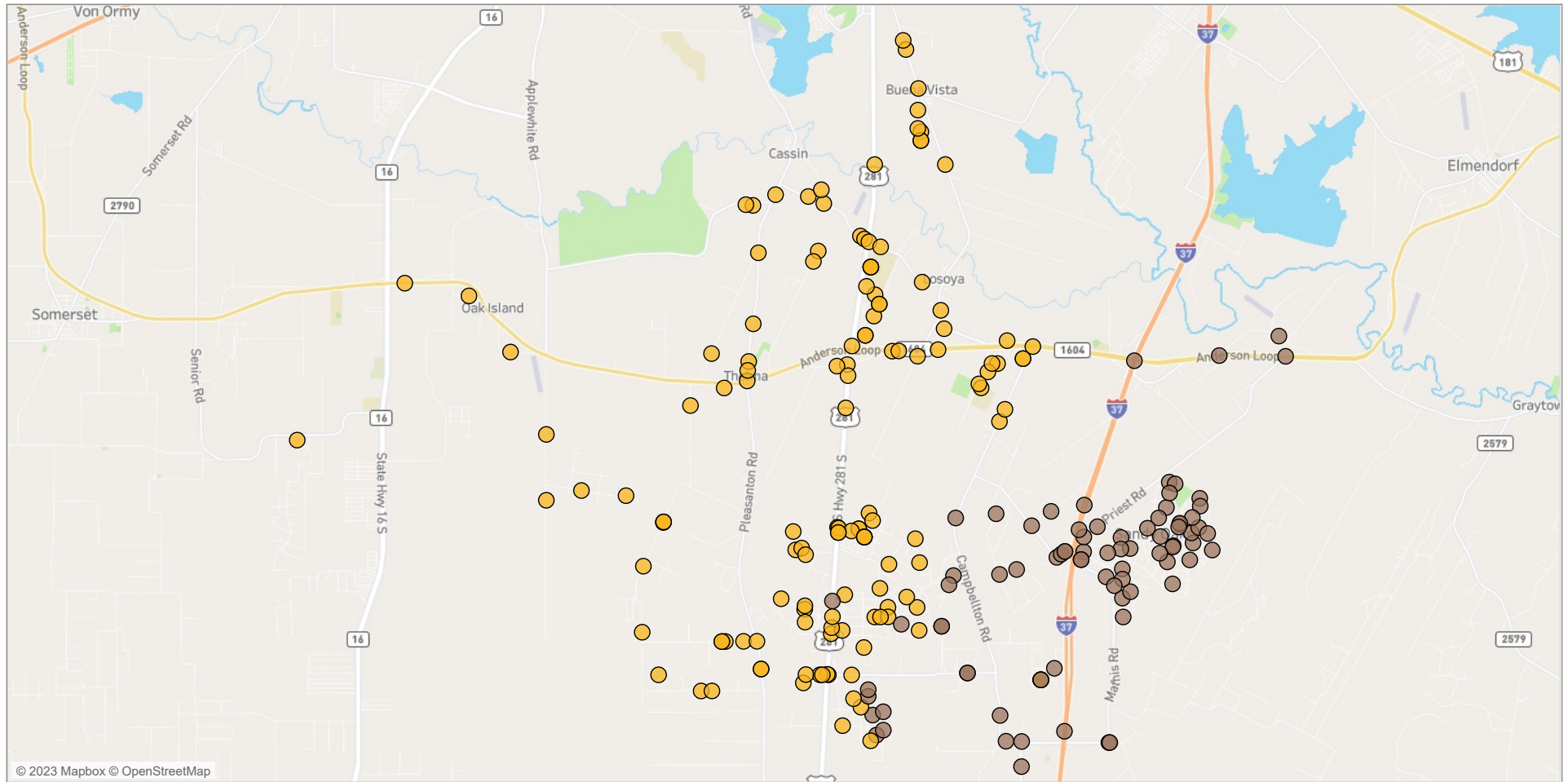

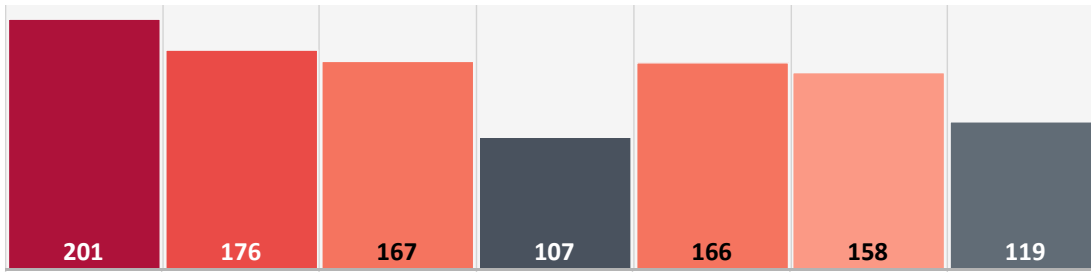

Department Incidents by Day & Hour

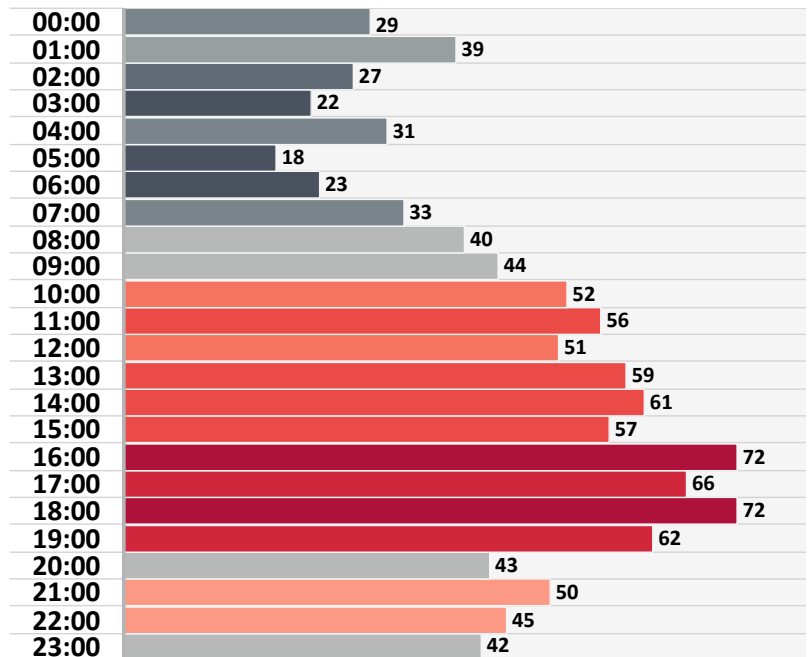
