4.) An Incident is a unique call for service event. A Response is a unit reaction to an Incident. One Incident may generate one or many Responses.

5.) Incident Response Time is the time in minutes from Incident Alarm to Incident Arrival. Measures using the Incident Response Time exclude incident records if either the Incident Alarm or Arrival times are missing or invalid.




