- 1.) Data Source: FireRMS

- 3.) Fire or EMS incident types are determined by the NFIRS incident code entered on the report. Rescue and Emergency Medical Service (EMS) Incidents (300 Series) incident types are classified as EMS incidents. All other incident type series are classified as Fire incidents.
- 4.) An Incident is a unique call for service event. A Response is a unit reaction to an Incident. One Incident may generate one or many Responses.
- 5.) Incident Response Time is the time in minutes from Incident Alarm to Incident Arrival. Measures using the Incident Response Time exclude incident records if either the Incident Alarm or Arrival times are missing or invalid.

The purchase contract for the 1.78 acres next to Station 121 has been executed with a 120 day feasibility study period. - Josh/Ralph Station 123 - Qualification were submitted on April 13, 2023. 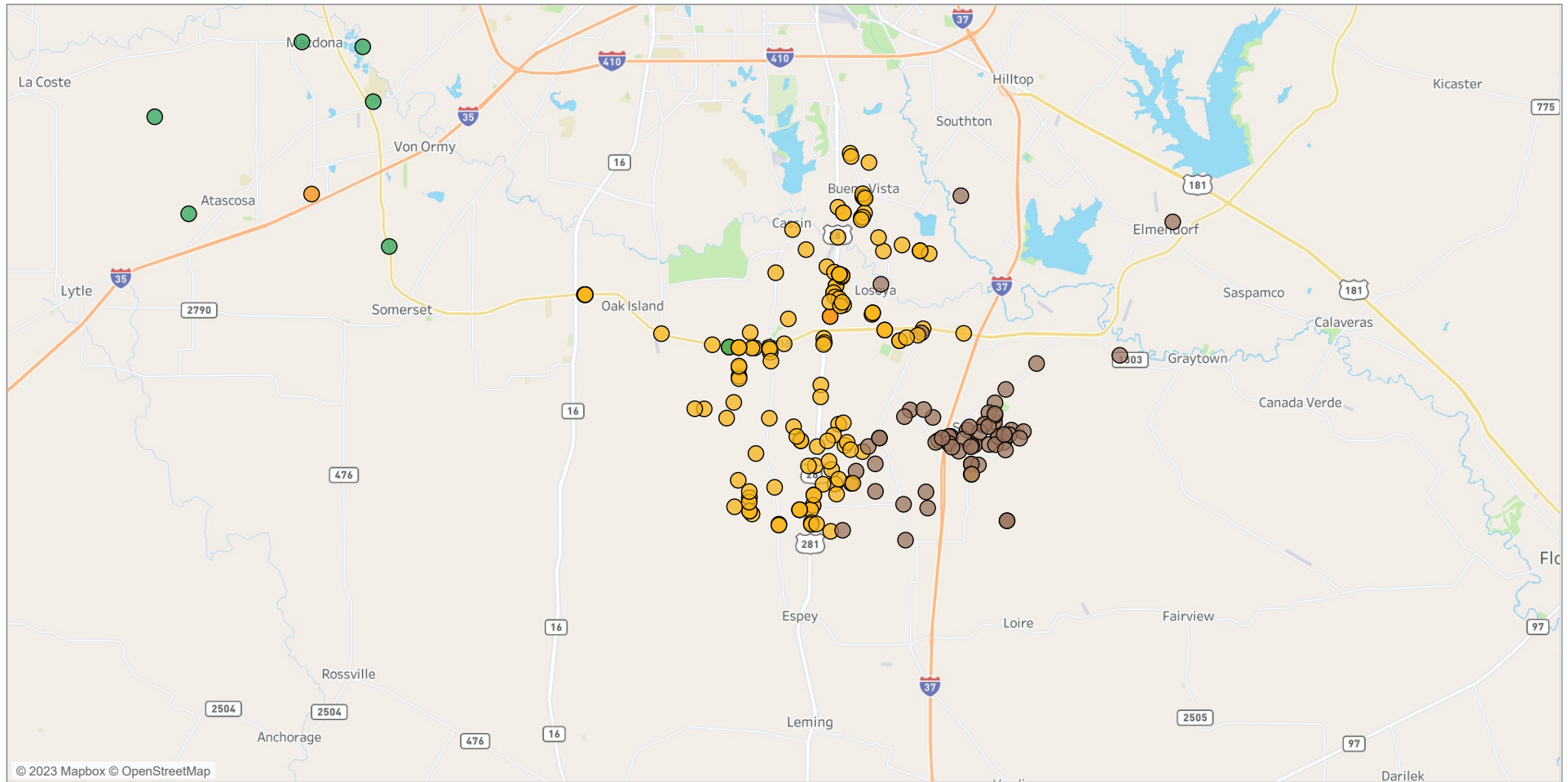

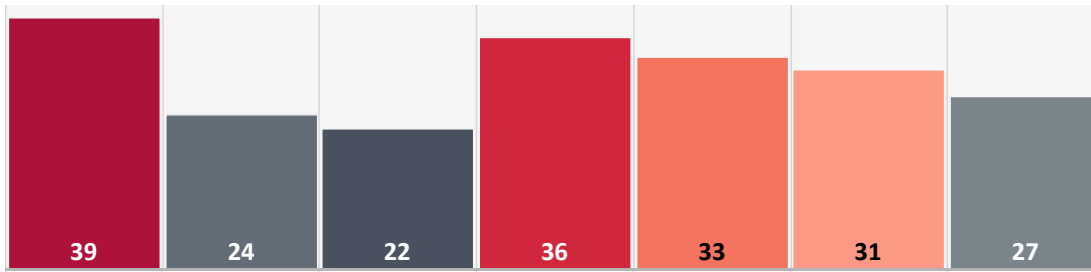

Department Incidents by Day & Hour

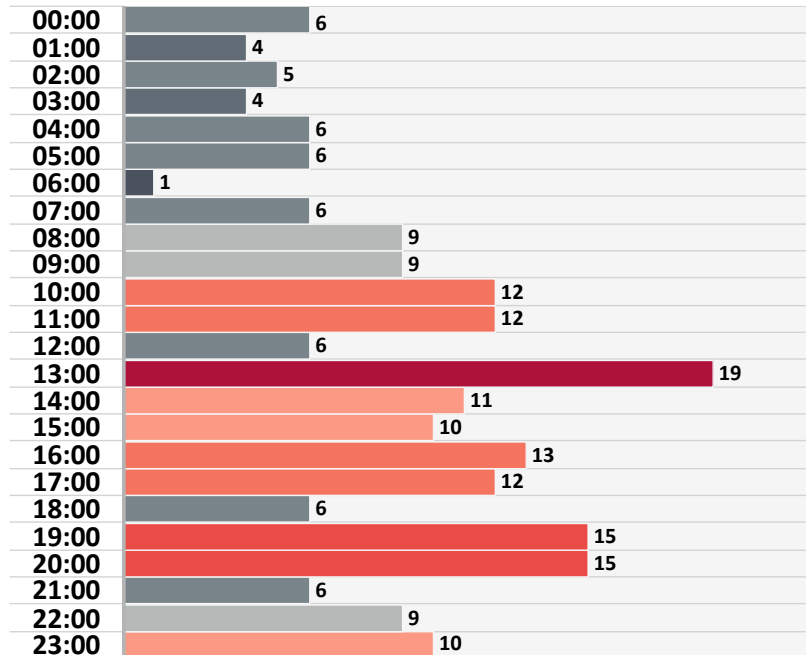

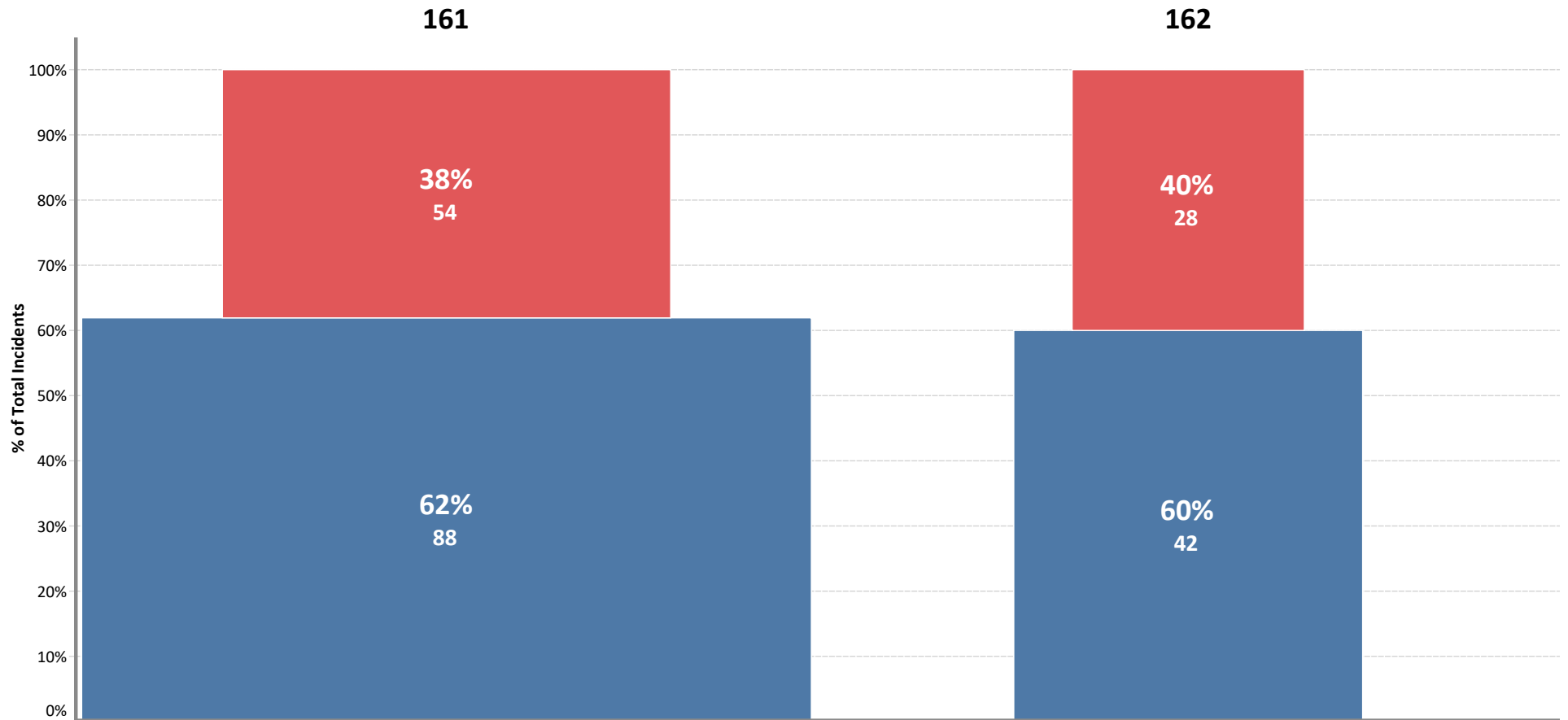
