Incident Locations by Responding Station

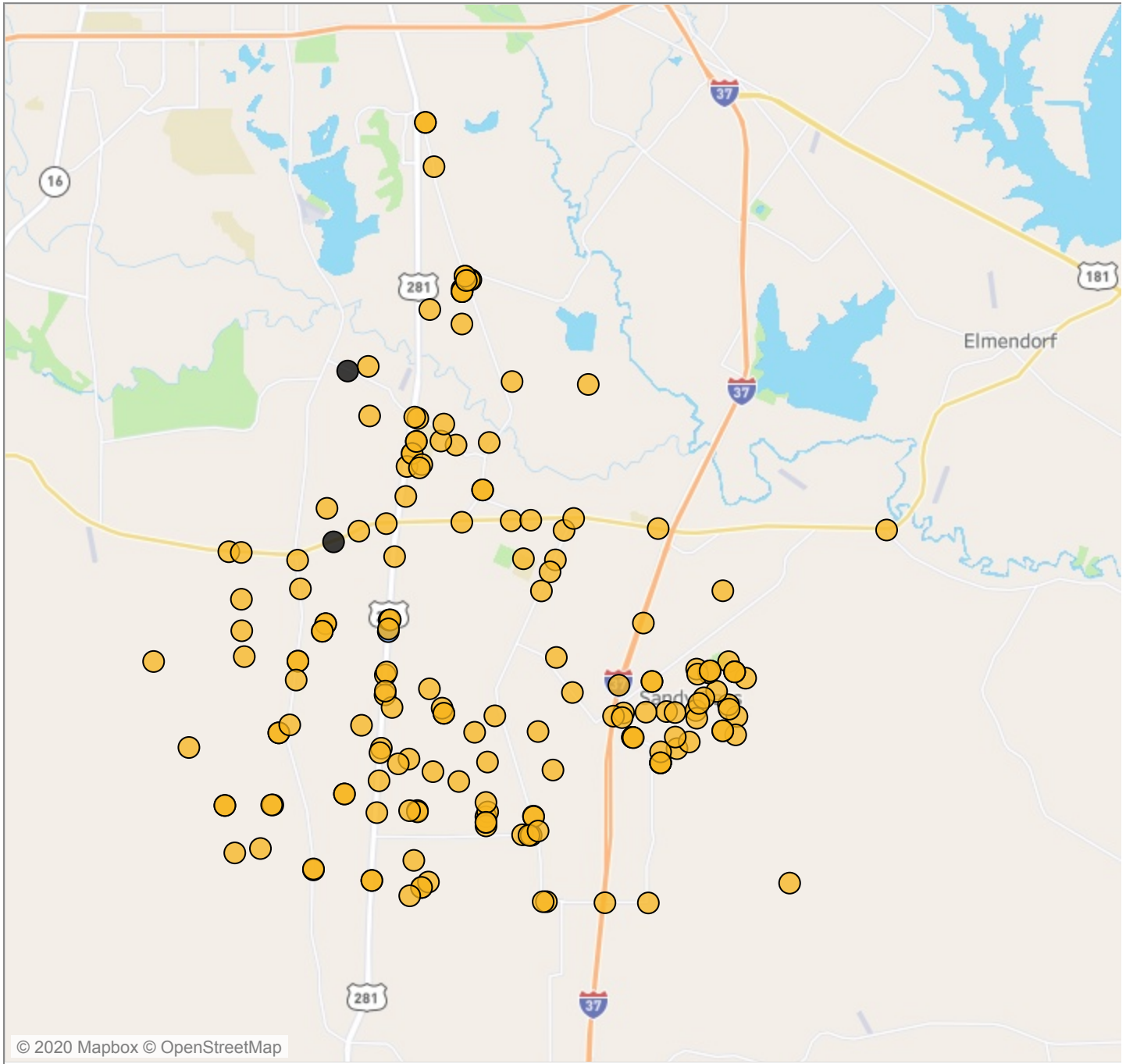

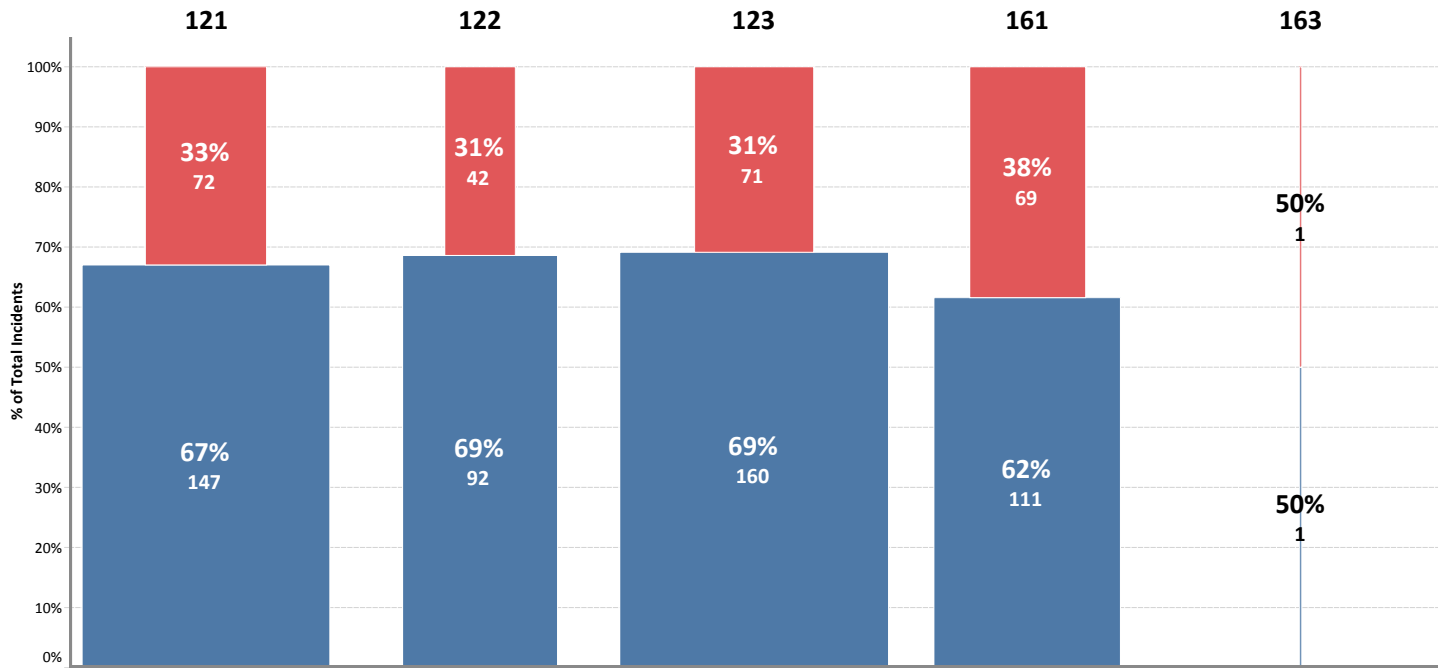

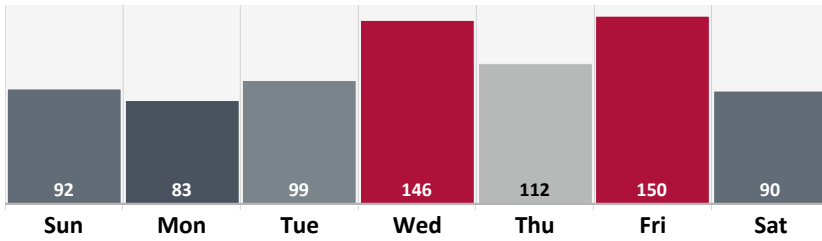
Fire / EMS Incidents by NFIRS Report Incident Type
