

**MINUTES
REGULAR MEETING
BEXAR COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT 6
SEPTEMBER 30, 2025**

In accordance with chapter 551 of the Texas Government Code, notice is hereby given to the public that the Board of Commissioners of Bexar County Emergency Service District No. 6 had a **REGULAR BOARD MEETING** on **SEPTEMBER 30, 2025** at 6:00 pm at 2220 S. Loop 1604 East, San Antonio, TX 78264.

1. Call the meeting to order and establish a quorum.

Meeting was called to order at 6:01 pm and a quorum was established. Board members in attendance were Isaac Griego, Christopher Cavazos, Edgar Castillo, Mike Shannon, and Mance Clark.

Motion by Commissioner Cavazos to accept the Interlocal Agreement between Bexar County ESD6 and ESD6 Fire & Rescue for 2025-2026 as submitted. Seconded by Commissioner Griego. Motion carried 5/0.

5. The Board will hear an update regarding any recent meetings of the Bexar County ESD Association, including any legislative updates, and plans for future meeting activity, if any

Commissioner Shannon said the Association talked about opening membership to ESDs outside of Bexar County. Chief Mark Montgomery said they did not want to compete with Safe-D so they may open membership just to neighboring counties.

Commissioner Cavazos noted the Association seems more geared towards operations. Commissioner Shannon said all the bills related to ESDs failed. He said Executive Director of the Association, Josh Brown suggested using the NextDoor app to communicate to the public. The next meeting is scheduled for October 9th at noon at Station 150 in Somerset. No action taken on this item.
